Counting Cookies

The set-up:

- You will need a small plate for each player plus one more.
- Cut out each individual cookie. Place the cookies in a pile on the extra plate.

To Play:


- Roll the dice.
- Place the number of cookies that match the number rolled on the die into the cookie jar.


When the cookie jar is filled, reverse the game and remove the number of cookies shown on the rolled die from the jar.


- After each roll, "share" the cookies with your PlaydateBox partner(s) so that everyone has an equal number of cookies. For example, if a #2 is rolled, and there are 2 players, each player gets 1 cookie. If a number 4 is rolled, each player would get 2 cookies.
- If there are more players than the number of cookies rolled, the player who rolled the die gets one of the cookies, and the rest go onto the extra plate.
- If someone rolls an odd number and there is an even number of players, the extra cookie is added to the extra plate. For example, if there are 2 players, and a number "3" is rolled, each PlaydateBox partner would get 1 cookie, and the extra goes back onto the extra game plate.

Continue playing until all the cookies are gone from the cookie jar.
